WHAT TO INCLUDE

These are all suggestions and not necessarily required.

Schedule of Events

If you are hosting several events throughout the weekend, such as welcome cocktails and/or a farewell brunch, it's really helpful to give guests a reminder of when and where these events will take place. Even if it's just the wedding and reception, it's not a bad idea.

Keep in mind that you may need to indicate "by invite only" on an event to which only some guests are invited, or you may opt not to include that one at all.

Map

While not completely necessary in the age of smartphones, a whimsical map can be great to help guests get a sense of the locations for events and of their surroundings. Mark key places and maybe some other fun spots - like where you got engaged or your favorite place to grab a drink.

Directions

Whether you include a map or not, written out directions can be helpful.

Transportation Details

If you are providing transportation to and/or from events, you'll want to share the pickup times and locations. Also, you may consider listing cab company phone numbers, etc.

Suggestions

Share some suggestions for where to eat and what to do while your guests are in town.

Emergency Contacts

We would not suggest putting the bride and groom's information here - you should be free to enjoy the day! - but you may consider listing your wedding planner or another appointed person just in case.

GETTING IT TO YOUR GUESTS

This service may be part of your package with your wedding planner or it may not. Often, these pieces are dropped off at hotels where you've reserved blocks to be given to guests at checkin. Other times, you could consider handing it out at the first event, such as the rehearsal dinner or welcome gathering.

FORMAT

The format for this piece varies widely, mostly based on what else you are including with it. Check out some examples on the next page.


